



The Wisconsin American Legion Riders purpose: To participate in parades and other ceremonies that are in keeping with the aims and purposes of the American Legion. To promote motorcycle safety. To provide a social atmosphere for American Legion members who share the same interests. To use our group to promote and support the programs of The American Legion, the community and other motorcycle organizations. We are not a motorcycle club. We are a group of American Legion Family Members who ride for a cause.

Registration Criteria

- 1. Helmets must be worn by driver and passenger when motorcycles are underway.
- 2. No consumption of any alcoholic beverages during the ride. Alcohol is permitted once motorcycles are parked for the evening.
- 3. All participants must attend the Safety Briefing on Sunday evening, June 27th held at Superior Post 435, 305 E 2nd St, Superior, WI, at 7:00 PM or contact Ride Committee to coordinate alternate Safety Briefing.
- 4. Every participant must bring a completed Medical Information Form with them to the Safety Briefing on Thursday evening.
- 5. Kick-Stands-Up on 6/28 will be @ 8:00 AM at Wisconsin Point Trail parking lot. KSU 6/29 @ 8:00 AM from Kwik Trip; KSU 6/30 @ 8:00 AM from Port Washington Post 82.
- 6. One fuel stop is planned for each day. We will do "community" fueling and each motorcycle will "round-up" to the nearest whole dollar. Please have ample ones and fives (\$1.00 & \$5.00) to avoid unnecessary delays. Change will not be given. Please have a full tank at the start of each day.
- 7. Flags mounted to motorcycles may not exceed 11" x 15". Flags can be USA, Legion Rider, POW/MIA, CMA, or any branch of the military.
- 8. If you are unable to ride the entire 3 days and wish to ride one/two, let us know in advance so you can receive the Safety Briefing before joining the ride.
- 9. If a motorcycle experiences mechanical difficulties, or, if the driver/passenger must pull to the roadside for any reason, the main body will continue moving forward. There will be medical and support on the ride to assist you.
- 10. No political flags, emblems and/or placards will be allowed.
